

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION FOR ROANE COUNTY, TENNESSEE

A RESOLUTION amending the Roane County Code of Ethics

WHEREAS, the Roane County Commission adopted an amended Code of Ethics at its meeting in December, 2008 (Resolution #12-08-11); and

WHEREAS, the amended Code of Ethics adopted at the December 2008 County Commission meeting is further amended by adding language to the 2nd paragraph of Section 5. Ethics Complaints as follows:

Questions and complaints regarding violations of this Code of Ethics, as defined in Section 1(D) of this policy, should be directed to the chair of the Ethics Committee. Complaints shall be in writing and signed by the person making the complaint, and shall set forth in reasonable detail the facts upon which the complaint is based. The complaint shall be completed on a form available at the Roane County Clerk's Office *and shall include a sworn statement.* The person being named in the complaint(s) shall have ten (10) business days after notification to respond in writing to the Chairman of the Ethics Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Roane County Commission does hereby adopt the amended Roane County Code of Ethics, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attached policy replaces the present Code of Ethics (Resolution #12-08-11), adopted at the December 2008 County Commission meeting.

SECTION 1. All resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are repealed insofar as such conflict exists.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall become effective upon passage, the public welfare requiring it.

Motion to adopt was made by Commissioner Brummett with second by Commissioner Hooks.

Motion Passed upon unanimous voice vote.

THEREUPON, the County Commission Chairman announced to the Commission that said resolution had received a constitutional majority and ordered same spread of record.
