- **Purpose:**
 - The purpose of this Emergency Support Function (ESF) is to coordinate local transportation in support of emergency responders. In major emergencies, large quantities of personnel, equipment, and supplies will be moving into the affected areas, and it is the responsibility of ESF 1 to coordinate this movement. Vehicle allocation is done by each department.

Sub Function 2 (Continued)

- **Purpose:**

- This sub function provides county staging areas to support emergency operations by designating locations to stage volunteers and temporarily store resources. These staging areas are different from those that Incident Commanders establish to stage response forces. The OES Director will keep Incident Commanders apprised of volunteer and resource staging areas being managed in this ESF, and will stay informed of the areas that Incident Commanders are using. Staging area selection and management is an important task that must in advance of a disaster and periodically reviewed.

- **Purpose:**

- This sub function of the Roane County Emergency Basic Operations Plan (BEOP) supports the Terrorism Annex of the Tennessee Emergency Management Plan (TEMP) and the Federal National Response Framework (NRF). It addresses direction and control, coordination, operations and follow-through during response to an act or the threat of an act of terrorism. The Annex addresses both Crises Management and Consequence Management and provides checklist for use before, during, and after such incidents and guidelines for responsibilities for agencies and personnel. This Annex does not supersede existing local or state laws governing emergency operations.

ESF16 Animal Care Services and Disease Management (Cont.)

- **Purpose:**
- 1. This Emergency Support Sub function establishes procedures to coordinate local government agencies, volunteer organizations, allied animal interest groups, and veterinary medical personnel to provide all animals affected by a man-made or natural disaster with emergency medical care, temporary confinement, housing, food and water, identification and tracking for return to owner and ultimate disposal of dead and unclaimed animals as necessary. The goals are; prevention of injury and illness in animals during disasters, prevention of the spread of infectious disease from animal to animal and from animals to humans, and by providing shelter for animals make it more likely that animal owners themselves will seek shelter knowing that their animals are being cared for in safer locations.

ESF16 Purpose (Cont.)

- **2. Categories of Emergencies:**
- a. **Natural/Man Made Disasters:** Any ecological or environmental event such as, but not limited to: floods, blizzards, tornados, hurricanes, ice storms, power outages, mud slides, or hazardous material spills/releases that may adversely affect or threaten animals.
- b. **Bio-terrorism:** The threatened use of biological agents against civilians/animals with the objective of causing fear, illness or death. Actual use will activate the Animal Disease Sub-Function.

ESF16 Animal Care Services and Disease Management

- **Purpose:**

- 1. This plan is designed to establish a multifaceted and coordinated approach by the USDA APHIS (United States Department of Agriculture Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service), Veterinary Services (VS) and the Tennessee Department of Agriculture's Department of Agriculture (IDA) for initial response to animal health emergencies.

- **This plan will:**

- a. Identify roles and responsibilities of USDA/APHIS Veterinary Services
- b. Identify roles and responsibilities of the Department of Agriculture
- c. Provide a directory of major contacts, support agencies, industry groups and organizations

- d. Provide a directory of state and federal employees potentially available to respond
- e. Provide a protocol for initial action plans to respond to animal health emergencies
- f. Provide a protocol for initial action plans to respond to natural disasters threatening animals.
