

Division of Emergency Communication (DEC)

- ▶ Weekly education/training is ongoing
- ▶ Two new members added since last report (total 17)
- ▶ Total of 3 exercises during October
 - TEMA/MARS/auxiliary comm exercise Oct 11
 - Assisted passing voice and digital (radio email) messages involving 5 served agencies across the state. Assist in training others.
 - Was able to assist by passing digital messages that Knox EOC could not handle. We are premier msg handling station in our region.
 - Assisted Anderson County ARES and Red Cross in passing messages and helping members set up for digital radio email in Anderson County SET
 - Participation with Roane Medical Center exercise, confirming operational status of new comm room

DEC, continued

- ▶ Working with EMS to help provide adequate radio reception of pages at Station 4 (SOR)
- ▶ Working with E911 and EMA to provide wireless link between EOC, Roosevelt Mtn tower site, and 911 Center
 - Success will allow 911 center to get rid of a monthly subscription for a hardwire connection to the mtn
 - Can also provide interlink with other locations to help with internet redundancy, provide internet to trailers
- ▶ Working with IT service to install CAD, strengthen servers, help with internet redundancy at EOC
- ▶ Day long training session and work day at comm trailer.
 - Volunteer member repaired broken entry steps
 - Working equipment exercised, deficiencies identified and are already in process of correction with support from Director Stout and Staff.
- ▶ Gathering of equipment for approved grant –funded portable station has begun
