



Division of Emergency Communication (DEC)

- ▶ Weekly training/education continues
 - ▶ Proof of Concept microwave link E911 to Roosevelt Mtn
 - Month of connection without connection failure – concept proven
 - E911 wants to purchase their own equipment for permanent link, saving probably >\$1500/year
 - ▶ Planning similar Proof of Concept link for EOC-to-mountain
 - ▶ Developing plans for microwave link for internet redundancy to E911, then to EOC
 - ▶ New local server for internal CAD is now set up in EOC
 - Training to follow for EOC & DEC personnel

 - ▶ Actively working with RMC administration to implement numerous improvements brought to light by recent exercise
 - ▶ Developing plan for DEC to staff RMC for exercises and incidents, as well as regular regional radio tests
 - ▶ Developing plan for DEC personnel to complete assembly & testing of equipment @ RMC
 - ▶ Provided consulting to Knox County & Anderson County for Winlink and MARS implementation
