

County Executive's Report May 11, 2015

2016 Budget work update:

- This Tuesday, May 12th, we have a budget meeting from 5 to 7 pm.
- This Thursday, May 14th, we start at 9am with the schools coming at 10am. We will try to finish up the balance of the County General Fund.
- Monday, June 1st, we hope to have the Budget Public Hearing, Budget Committee and then a Commission Work Session.
- Monday, June 8th, we hope to have the budget ready for commission consideration.

Here are some of our issues:

1. Completing our review work
2. Decision on consolidation of and forming a Planning Department with our cities and GIS Department with a change in administration from the Property Assessor to a new department.
3. Approval of the 2020 Reappraisal Plan.
4. Potential tax increase
5. Completion of reappraisal and having a certified tax rate.
