Convenience Centers

- First Center opened in mid-eighties.
- Permanent closure of Blair convenience center January 1, 2013 due to redundant service.
- Currently 12 Centers.
- Highway 58 South, Gallaher Road, and Orchard View are Super Centers.
- Super Centers are geared towards high volume areas that are capable of collecting most recyclable materials.
- A Solar panel cardboard compactor has been introduced to the Orchard View location.
- Recycled oil is being used to heat the Recycling center along with the Animal Control Department and the Highway Department.

How did Roane County's recycling services go from rural to regional?

- The County received a Hub & Spoke Grant that requires us to reach outside of the local area and include municipalities, schools, businesses, and other counties into our recycling program.
- The grant received from TDEC (\$265,000.00) for purchasing a larger baler and to upgrade the storage area for recycled products. The county added an additional \$100,000.00 to complete the project.
- Roane County has also purchased a new sorting line to make operations more efficient. The sort line total cost is \$103,00.000. The equipment was purchased with the help of a Recycle Equipment Grant from TDEC (\$25,000.00) for a total of \$78,000.00 expenditure of county funds. It is estimated it will increase production by at least 40% in the first year of operation.
