#### General Information

##### **Basic Firefighting Training**

This course is designed to provide basic firefighter skills that are necessary to perform on a fire ground. This course is structured with safety being the number 1 priority of all firefighters and recruits. Selected sections of NFPA 1001: Firefighter Professional Qualifications will be taught to meet the basic skill level so recruits may participate in “live” fire training activities. Each recruit that completes this course, passes all required written examinations and passes all required practical examinations will receive a certificate for Basic Firefighting. Firefighting is a mentally and physically challenging activity and recruits will be challenged mentally and physically for the duration of this course.

#### Pre-Course Requirements

- 18 Years of Age;
- Valid medical evaluation / physical for firefighting within 1 year prior of course start date;
- National Incident Management System (NIMS) online courses: **IS-100** Introduction to Incident Command System, **IS-200** ICS for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents, **IS-700** NIMS An Introduction, **IS-800** National Response Framework, An Introduction;
- TFACA FF050 Introduction to Fire and Emergency Services (16 hours)

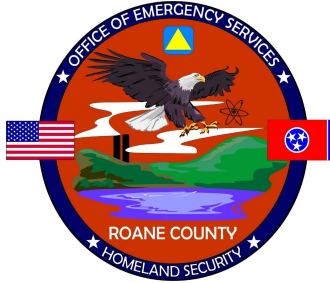

#### **Properly Identify Tools and Equipment Used on the Fireground.**

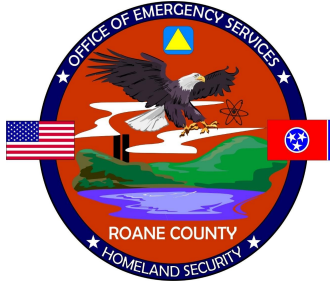
#### **Perform Basic Skills Used on the Fireground.**

### Grading Policy

Recruits must have at least a **70%** average to obtain certification from course.

### Class Attendance

Attendance is part of the overall grade for this course and is required to obtain certification. Any classes missed must be made up with the instructors. Tardiness and leaving class early will only be tolerated if prior notification to the instructors is made and an approval is issued. Any time missed must be made up to receive certification.

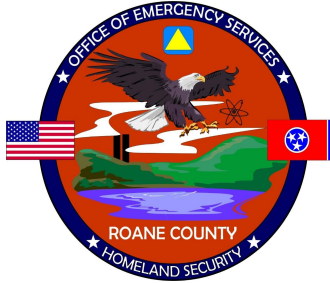

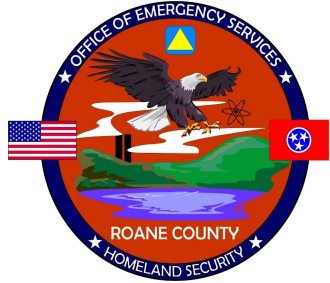
