

County Executive's Report
February 12, 2018

The following correspondence were reviewed:

- **Correspondence #6:** Roane County has billed DOE for their In Lieu of Tax Payment. We have not received any of these payments. DOE indicated they were waiting on the Federal Budget Adoption. The budget was adopted last week.
- **Correspondence #12:** Roane County Park's Director Mike Beard noted the courtesy docks and shoreline stabilization projects which were completed and projects that are waiting permits. The Hine Creek's project has also been completed since the filing of the report.
- **Correspondence #14:** Ambulance Director Tim Suter noted in the correspondence the search for a South of the River Ambulance Station.
- **Correspondence #16, 17, and 18:** Are reports of the Sales Tax exemption issues related to UT Battelle. Those reports have been updated and noted on the attached report, which was discussed with Commission. Directors of Schools Leah Watkins, Oak Ridge City Manager Mark Watson, and Executive Woody have a scheduled meeting February 21st with the TN Commission of Revenue in Senator Yager's office to further discuss the sales tax exemption issues.
- **Correspondence #19 and #20:** Are the required filing for the bond refunding resolution 02-18-19.

Other Business Discussed:

- The **property committee** met on February 5th. One of the main topics was to review nine (9) properties in and around the courthouse and jail in relation to additional needs for the jail expansion, jail construction lay down lot, and relieving parking issues. The committee would initially be recommending three properties: Spring Street lot, two lots directly behind the jail and building and codes lot. Resolutions will be filed next month.
