This is Ron Woody, Roane County Executive, with a Monday morning June, 29 update.

The reporting data for today is from Saturday, June 27. We review the data daily, which is posted on the State of Tennessee Department of Health's website and is generally updated at 3:00pm each day. Sunday's data was not posted due to an unplanned shutdown of the state surveillance system.

The duration of the shutdown is unknown at this time.

Roane County stands at 43 positive cases, 32 recoveries, leaving 11 active cases. We have tested 5,246 individuals.

For the viewers who may not be aware, our office publishes a monthly newsletter, which reports various activities related to county government and our community. Also, published in the newsletter is the monthly calendar of meetings and Robert Bailey, our county Historian /Archivist always publishes a bit of Roane County History.

This July edition has an excellent article submitted by the Roane Medical Center's Leadership team on how our local hospital and the Covenant Health System as a whole have implemented their infections control and emergency preparation plan in response to COVID-19.
