Press Release

This is Ron Woody with a Friday, November 13, 2020 4:15 pm update. I hate to report that since Monday, November 9th we have added three (3) deaths, bringing our deaths due to Covid-19 to 13.

We have 298 active cases. We reported 49 new positive cases today.

Our rankings with our adjacent counties which, I thought was important, have fallen from 3rd place on November 2nd to now 6th place just 11 days later. We are performing quite a bit worse than our adjacent counties.

Our five (5) day average is 32.4 cases per day. Our 10-day average is 32.9, and our 30-day average is 25.2.

In August, our average was 10.35 per day. September and October we were at 8.87 cases per day, and now in November we are at 31.08.

It appears some of our cities have canceled Christmas parades. I anticipate additional restrictions if the climb in numbers continue.

51.7% of our population has been tested with 3.5% testing positive which is 1, 864.

84% of our positive cases have recovered.

Let me continue to say that I think it's important to wear our facial coverings/masks. Social distance when you can, and practice good clean hygiene.

In a previous report I have shared, I mentioned how we would put a dot on our watch when at work to help us remember to be safe. Let the mask be that warning.

If nothing else, let our facial coverings be a reminder to us to be safe.

Whether you believe it works or not, it's a reminder you need to wash your hands and social distance.

Let's pray we come out of this pretty quick.
