Plant Capacity

• Plant Capacity is 1,000,000 gallons per day

• The plant is currently operating at 40% capacity – 400,000 gallons per day

Pump Stations

- 14 pump systems are currently on the system
 - 7 are owned by other entities
 - Roane State Community College
 - Renaissance Terrace Care and Rehabilitation
 - Tennessee Valley Authority
 - College Grove Apartments
 - Caney Creek RV Park
 - Caney Creek Marina
 - Harbor Freight

• 180 STEP or E-1 Systems are owned by individual businesses or homes

Sewage System

• Approximately 737 residential, 155 Commercial, and 23 industrial customers – 6 of which are included in the pretreatment program.

• Approximately 17 ¹/₂ miles of gravity collection mains

• Approximately 24 ³/₄ miles of force main

• Service area covers approximately 26,880 acres
