



# FREE SMOKE ALARMS

**Did you know that it is recommended that each room in your residence have a working smoke alarm and that smoke alarms should be replaced every 10 years?**

**The Tennessee State Fire Marshal's Office has a program, in coordination with your local fire department, that provides eligible residents with FREE smoke alarms. New residential construction and apartment complexes are not eligible. These FREE alarms must be installed by fire personnel.**
